What to Expect

Wildlife abounds, striking sunsets, brisk winds off the ocean and the mountains, and forest, lakes and rivers. With varying degrees of difficulty, IATNL offers easy, flat road walks, undulating roadway treks through the forest, and mountain trails to excite and tantalize the most experienced of hikers.

How to Get Here

By air travelers can choose between three airports: Deer Lake (YDF), Stephenville (YNF) and St. Anthony (YAY), depending on the airline they would like to fly with and the trails they plan to hike. The overland route requires a Marine Atlantic ferry ride from North Sydney, NS to Port aux Basques, NL. There you will find the southern terminus of the IATNL, as well as the DRL cross-island bus line (www.drlgroup.com).
